Included in this pack are a variety of products that will enable staff to communicate more effectively with visitors who are deaf or hard of hearing. The equipment will also enable visitors to use television and radio facilities and participate socially with other visitors or friends.

## SMALL CASE 1

### Crescendo 20 Plus

– with neckloop and headphones for patients with or without hearing aids

The Crescendo can be used for one to one communication or for TV and hi-fi listening. The staff/visitor wears the microphone, the patient wears the headphones or neck loop.

The headphones are for use by patients who do not wear a hearing aid.

The neckloop is for use by patients with hearing aids which have a 'T' facility.

## SMALL CASE 2

### Connevans PPS Personal Pager System

– for customers with or without hearing aids

The Connevans PPS personal pager system with fire alert provides a wire free night use alerting facility for those who would not hear conventional fire alarms. The PPS trigger should be placed beside an adjacent alarm bell and the vibrating pager carried in a pocket or placed in the pillowcase for night use.

In the event of an emergency we always advice making specific provision for ensuring that the fire brigade are informed that deaf people are on the premises.

## MEDIUM CASE

### Communicator

– This could be described as an electronic ear trumpet for non-hearing aid wearers

This is a lightweight stetoclip incorporating an amplifier with built in microphone. Designed for use with the elderly, bedridden and infirm and ideal for use where health professionals need to communicate with patients.

The wearer puts the earpieces in their ears with the control unit hanging down. There is a combined ON/OFF switch with Hi/Lo tone adjustment and a volume control.

The following two items are for personal use by those with hearing aids with a 'T' facility. Both products can be plugged into any equipment which has a headphone socket eg. personal radios, minidisks, CD players, cassettes, talking book machines etc. Most hearing aids have their microphones turned off when turned to 'T' so don't be surprised if a user does not hear you!

### Personal Inductive Neck Loop

A personal inductive neck loop which can be plugged in any conventional headphone socket. Plug it in, slip the neck loop over the head and switch the hearing aid to 'T'.

### Silent Headphones

These are a pair of headphones with special coils that work with the hearing aid's 'T' facility.

Used with two hearing aids they will give a stereo signal, when used with mono equipment only one side will be heard.

## LARGE CASE

### Doorknock Beacon

– for customers with or without hearing aids

Compact unit which hangs on the inside of the door and flashes when someone knocks on the other side. The product is activated by vibration rather than sound.

### Minicom 6000

– a textphone for those who are deaf or who have a speech impairment

#### What is a textphone?

A textphone has a keyboard and scrolling character display screen. Instead of speaking into a telephone mouthpiece, you type what you want to say and it appears on the textphone screens of both yours and the person you are calling.

A textphone requires the use of an ordinary telephone line. There are two methods of connection either directly to a BT socket using the lead and doubler supplied or indirectly by placing the telephone handset into the acoustic couplers on the top of the unit.

Making a text phone call is easy, dial the number and wait for a reply. When making a Textphone call the two callers take it in turns to type.

Full details of textphone use are included in the user instruction guide.
