Phonak MicroMLxS

The MicroMLxS is the latest fm ear level receiver from Phonak. Not only is the MicroMLxS smaller than its MLxS predecessor but with an improved aerial there is no need for orientation to match a hearing aid.

The MicroMLxS has high visual appeal and good sound quality. Compatible hearing aids are required but due to its small size and ease of losing, the MicroMLxS is not suited to all users!
