To enhance the use of your fmGenie system you can add a second transmitter to utilise the fmGenie receiver dual channel facility.

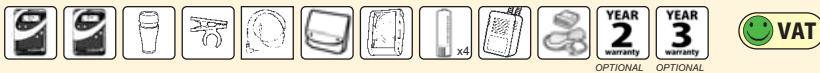

FMGQ9 fmGenie transmitter set:

A second fmGenie transmitter for use by a second speaker, or connection to a TV – ideal for use in large meetings, or for audio visual presentations.

In education this pack is very effective for use by a learning support assistant.
